(a) whether Government has taken note of the decline in the export of automobiles, particularly cars, during the last five years;
(b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
(c) the automobile-wise number of automobiles including cars exported from the country during each of the last five years including current year ;
(d) whether Government has given any incentive to exporters to increase export of automobiles, if so, the details thereof; and
(e) the other steps taken/being taken by Government to promote export of automobiles?

The data in the above table reveals that export of total number of automobiles increased from $41,34,047$ in 2020-21 to $56,17,246$ in 2021-22, registering a positive growth of $35.9 \%$. Out of this, export of Passenger vehicles including cars increased from 4,04,397 in 2020-21 to 5,77,875 in 2021-22, registering a positive growth of $42.9 \%$.
(d) \& (e): Government of India has been taking various proactive measures to boost exports. The Government regularly reviews export performance of different sectors, including automobile sector and need based measures are taken from time to time for boosting export performance.
