Potential of Andhra Pradesh in fisheries

411. Shri Masthan Rao Beeda:

Will the Minister of **Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Andhra Pradesh has considerable potential in the fisheries and aquaculture industries;
- (b) the details of the establishment of brood banks in the State;
- (c) whether it is a fact that under the brood component, zero allocation was made to Andhra Pradesh for brood bank establishment in financial years 2021-22;
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (e) whether the same was rectified in the following year; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof, if not, the reasons therefor?

(b): Details of brood banks established in the State, as reported by the Government of Andhra Pradesh (AP) are as below:

1.	Fresh water Fish Brood Bank for Indian Major Carp (IMC)	Government Fish Seed Farm Badampudi Eluru District, AP
2.	Genetically Improved Farm Tilapia (GIFT) Brood Bank	Government Fish Seed Farm, Anantha Puram District, AP
3.	Fish Brood Bank (IMC)	Government Fish Seed Farm B.Mattam, YSR Kadapa District, AP
4.	Fish Brood Bank, Kadium	Government Fish Seed Farm East Godavari District, AP
5.	Fish Brood Bank, Undi	Undi, West Godavari District, AP

(c) to (f): The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Government of India under the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) has accorded approval for establishment of a fish brood bank in Andhra Pradesh during the FY 2020-21. As there was no proposal for establishment of Fish Brood Bank submitted by the Government of Andhra Pradesh during FY 2021-22, no allocation under the PMMSY was made for brood bank establishment in Andhra Pradesh during aforesaid financial years.
