(a) & (b) Since August 2019, Government of India in partnership with States is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) — Har Ghar Jal to make provision of potable water to every rural household of the country by 2024 including those in Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand and Odisha, through tap water connection.
