**Benefit under Centre's COVID-19 Schemes**

608. SHRI ABIR RANJAN BISWAS:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) details of total number of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) registered and functional in the States of West Bengal and Jharkhand, district-wise, and MSMEs which applied for closure during the last two years in West Bengal and Jharkhand, district-wise;
- (b) details of number of MSMEs which took benefit under Centre's COVID-19 Schemes in West Bengal and Jharkhand, Scheme-wise and district-wise; and
- (c) details of number of MSMEs which applied for the benefits under the Centre's ₹ 3 lakh crore emergency credit line in West Bengal and Jharkhand, district-wise?

**ANSWER**

(a): The details of total number of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) registered and functional in the States of West Bengal and Jharkhand, district-wise are at Annexure-I.

The details of MSMEs which applied for closure during the last two years in West Bengal and Jharkhand, district-wise are at Annexure-II.

(b) & (c): The Government has taken a number of recent initiatives to support MSMEs in the country, including the States of West Bengal and Jharkhand. Some of these include:

- i. Rs. 5 lakh crore Collateral Free Automatic Loans under Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme (ECLGS) for business, including MSMEs.
- ii. Rs. 50,000 crore equity infusion through MSME Self-Reliant India Fund.
- iii. New revised criteria for classification of MSMEs.
- iv. No global tenders for procurement up to Rs. 200 crores.
- v. "Udyam Registration" for MSMEs, for Ease of Doing Business.
- vi. Launching of an online Portal "Champions" in June, 2020 to cover many aspects of e-governance including redressing grievances and handholding of MSMEs.
- vii. Inclusion of Retail and Wholesale traders as MSMEs w.e.f. 02.07.2021.
- viii. Non-tax benefits extended for 3 years in case of an upward change in status of MSMEs.

The district-wise details of MSMEs of West Bengal and Jharkhand which have benefitted under the Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme (ECLGS) are at Annexure-III.
