- (b) whether Government plans to open more such dispensaries;
- (c) whether there is a shortage of Ayurvedic medicines at these dispensaries; and

- (a) to (b) State/ UT-wise details of CGHS Wellness Centres are at Annexure. Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance has approved opening of 16 new CGHS Wellness Centres.
- (c) In case, any Ayurvedic medicine is not readily available, the beneficiary is permitted to purchase the same from open market and claim reimbursement thereof.
- (d) A case of proprietary Ayurvedic medicine, categorized as misbranded, is discontinued.
