TB INTERVENTION PROGRAMME

766: SHRI PRABHAKAR REDDY VEMIREDDY :

Will the **Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Ministry has identified 75 tribal districts in the country for TB intervention programme;
- (b) if so, the details of districts identified from Andhra Pradesh and Telangana for this purpose;
- (c) the details of focused interventions proposed to make identified districts TB-free;
- (d) whether it is also a fact that the Ministry has undertaken a campaign and more than 3 lakh people have been identified for presumptive TB;
- (e) if so, how many people have finally been detected with TB out of above 3 lakhs, district-wise; and
- (f) the status of treatment of identified TB patients?

ANSWER

**THE MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE
(DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)**

- (a) to (f): The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare in collaboration with Ministry of Tribal Affairs has developed a Joint Action Plan for a Tribal TB Initiative, which is implemented in notified tribal districts including community adoption of TB patients i.e. Ni-kshay 2.0. The details of focused interventions under this initiative are as under:
- i) Demand generation for TB Services through engagement of tribal communities, community influencers & Panchayati Raj Institutions
 - ii) Decentralized TB service delivery involving Health & Wellness Centres
 - iii) Community outreach and door-to-door campaign
 - iv) Strengthen diagnostic and treatment centres
 - v) TB preventive treatment for eligible contacts

Under this initiative, the Ministry had conducted a campaign from January to September 2022 in tribal districts wherein 382,251 people were identified as presumptive TB. Out of these, 10,249 were detected with TB and 9849 patients (96%) were initiated on treatment. The district wise details of TB cases detected under this campaign is placed as **Annexure-I**.
