**GOVERNMENT MEDICAL COLLEGES IN ANDHRA PRADESH**

**777. SHRI SUBHAS CHANDRA BOSE PILLI:**

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of Government Medical Colleges in the country, State-wise;
- (b) whether Government proposes to establish more Government Medical Colleges in Andhra Pradesh;
- (c) if so, the details thereof, and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether Government proposes to modernise, improve and expand existing Government Medical Colleges in Andhra Pradesh; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof, and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (e): The State-wise details of Government Medical Colleges functioning in the country are at Annexure.

The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare administers a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for 'Establishment of new Medical Colleges attached with existing district/referral hospitals' with preference to underserved areas and aspirational districts, where there is no existing Government or private medical college. Under the Scheme, the envisaged 157 new medical colleges have been approved in three phases including three medical colleges in Andhra Pradesh.

Under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY), 03 Government Medical Colleges have been approved for upgradation in Andhra Pradesh to improve tertiary health infrastructure through construction of Super Specialty Blocks / Trauma Care Centres etc. and procurement of medical equipment.

Under the CSS for upgradation of Central/State Government Medical Colleges for increasing MBBS seats, 150 MBBS seats were approved for increase in 03 Medical Colleges of Andhra Pradesh. Further, under two phases of CSS for Strengthening and upgradation of State Government Medical Colleges for starting new PG discipline and increasing PG seats, total of 1040 PG seats have been approved for increase in 11 Medical Colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh.
