INCREASE IN THE USE OF GREEN HYDROGEN

- (a) whether it is a fact that oil refineries, fertiliser companies and steel producers have been asked to meet a compulsory Green Hydrogen Purchase Obligation (GHPO) in a planned national move to green energy;
- (b) if so, details thereof;
- (c) whether any sectors will be expected to start using green hydrogen on voluntary basis to facilitate the shift to green hydrogen;
- (d) if so, details thereof;
- (e) whether Government has planned to announce a comprehensive green hydrogen mission for increasing its usage in the upcoming years; and
- (f) if so, details thereof and which sectors will be the primary focus for adoption of green hydrogen?

- (c) to (f) In the Independence Day speech on August 15, 2021, Hon'ble Prime Minister announced the launch of National Hydrogen Mission. The Ministry of New and Renewable Energy has accordingly prepared a draft Mission document which inter-alia proposes to support production and deployment of Green Hydrogen.

Green Hydrogen can potentially be used to replace fossil fuels and fossil fuel based feedstocks in a number of sectors *inter alia* including fertilizer production, petroleum refining, steel production and transport applications.
