(a): The details of number of available and vacant seats in undergraduate engineering institutions approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) in the last five years in the country are as under:

| Academic Year | Total Approved Intake | Vacant Seats |

| $2017-18$ | $14,65,873$ | $7,22,112$ |
| $2018-19$ | $13,95,345$ | $6,78,932$ |
| $2019-20$ | $13,28,247$ | $5,87,314$ |
| $2020-21$ | $12,86,545$ | $5,66,538$ |
| $2021-22$ | $12,53,337$ | $4,21,203$ |

(b): The filling up of seats in engineering institutes is dependent on demand- supply situation which is dependent on location of the institutes, academic and infrastructural facilities therein and the placement opportunities.
