Extension campuses of IIT, Delhi in Jhajjar and Sonapat

Shri Deepender Singh Hooda:

Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the status of work on the extension campuses of Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), Delhi in Jhajjar and Sonapat districts of Haryana;
- (b) whether it is a fact that there is an unprecedented delay in completion of work on the campus at Jhajjar in Haryana;
- (c) the time by when the work would be completed and Jhajjar campus will start functioning in full capacity and when; and
- (d) the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) The total land allotted to IIT Delhi by Haryana Government for Sonipat campus is about 50 acres. Currently, two facilities viz. IIT Delhi Technopark (I-TEC) and Central Research Facility (CRF) are fully functional in Sonapat campus. With regard to Jhajjar Campus, 50 Acre land parcel at village Badsa has been allotted to IIT Delhi.

(b) No, Sir.

(c) & (d) IIT Delhi gave acceptance to establish the extension campus at Jhajjar on 6th January 2022. The quantitative survey work of the site is completed and the soil testing work is ongoing. The work related to construction of buildings, development of R&D facilities would be completed during the next 5 years, after which the campus will start functioning in full capacity.
