Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Ministry is considering establishing the Ardh Sainik Welfare Board on the lines of Haryana Government in other States;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) if not, the reasons therefor;

(d) whether there is any proposal in consideration for establishment of Ardh Sena Flag Day Fund; and

(e) if so, the details thereof and, if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI NITYANAND RAI)

(a) (b) & (c): The Ministry has already established the Welfare and Rehabilitation Board (WARB) to look after the welfare and rehabilitation of retired CAPFs personnel and their families including NoKs of deceased/disabled personnel. Welfare and Rehabilitation Board (WARB) has further designated State Welfare Officers (SWOs) and District Welfare Officers (DWOs) in States/UTs.

(d) & (e): There is no common flag representing all Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) & Assam Rifles (AR). Each CAPF has its own flag and celebrates its raising day separately.
