CONSTRUCTION OF BRIDGE ON SON RIVER BETWEEN BIHAR AND JHARKHAND

895. SHRI SAMIR ORAON:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government has planned to build a bridge on Son river between Bihar and Jharkhand;
- (b) if so, the total estimated cost of the construction of bridge;
- (c) whether it would reduce the distance from Panduka in Bihar to Garhwa in Jharkhand from 200 kilometer to just 63 kilometer; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) To (d) Yes, Sir. Government has approved construction of a bridge on Son river between Bihar and Jharkhand at a cost of Rs. 204 .94 crores under Central Road and Infrastructure Fund (CRIF) Scheme. After completion of bridge, the distance from Panduka in Bihar to Garhwa in Jharkhand will be reduced from 200 kilometers to 63 kilometers via Panduka -Srinagar -Kandi Road-Manjhiaon-Garhwa.
