UNEMPLOYMENT STATUS OF PMKVY TRAINED YOUTHS

922. SHRI RAJEEV SHUKLA:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:-

- (a) the aims and objectives of the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY);
- (b) the number of young people trained under the programme and the details thereof, State-wise; and
- (c) whether the Ministry has mechanism to seek real time employability status of PMKVY trained youth, if so, the employment status of PMKVY trained youth, State-wise, for the last five years?

ANSWER

- (a) Ministry is delivering skills through Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) with an objective to impart short duration skill development training and certification to youth to make them employable for better livelihood.
- (b) The State/UT-wise candidates trained/oriented under PMKVY, since inception i.e. 2015 upto 30.09.2022, is given at *Column (a) of Annexure*.
- (c) The life cycle of training process of candidates (enrolment – training – assessment – certification - placement) is tracked or monitored on real-time basis through the Skill India Portal (SIP) which is linked with Aadhaar-enabled biometric attendance.

PMKVY has two training component namely; Short Term Training (STT) and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). Under PMKVY, placement opportunities are being provided to STT certified candidates, while RPL is not linked with placements as it recognizes the existing skills of candidate. The State/UT-wise candidates placed under PMKVY-STT, in last five years i.e. 2017-22, are given at *Column (b) of Annexure*.
