Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the DDA or the Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) has taken any initiative to repair the broken roads inside and outside of the society in Pocket-8, Sector 23B, Dwarka, Delhi having 2360 flats constructed for the Economically Weaker Sections(EWS); and;
- (b) whether any information regarding any further repairing of the roads in this pocket to be carried out by MCD is available; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof along with the facts?

STATEMENT

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NUMBER 109 REGARDING "MAINTENANCE OF ROADS IN DWARKA, DELHI" FOR ANSWER ON FEBRUARY 13, 2023.

(a): Delhi Development Authority (DDA) has informed that it initiated the repair of internal roads of Pocket - 8, Sector – 23B, Dwarka in January 2022. DDA has further informed that the contract had to be rescinded as the contractor did not undertake bituminous work. Meanwhile, action was initiated to hand over these roads to MCD by the DDA.

There are two external roads one of 30 metre ROW and another 12 metre ROW connecting this Pocket – 8, Sector-23B, Dwarka, at the entry gate and exit gate, respectively. Till the handing over to MCD is completed, repair work of both internal and external roads of Pocket – 8, Sector 23B, Dwarka is being carried out by the DDA on the request of local residents/RWA, and is scheduled for completion in April, 2023.
