- (c) The percentage of women benefitted from PM Awas Yojana under the Gender Budget in the last five years;
- (d) The details of overall Government spending on the schemes benefitting women in the last five years;
- (e) Whether the Government plans to include Jal Jeevan Mission and PM Mudra Yojana in the Gender Budget; and
- (f) If so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) The allocation to Gender Budget in the last five years, year-wise is as under: -

- **(b)** The details of all the schemes in Part A and Part B of the Gender Budget are attached as per **Annexure-A**.
- (c) During last five years, 99.52 lakh houses were sanctioned under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana Urban (PMAY-U), of which 86% (85.93 lakh) houses are in the name of women beneficiaries. Under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana Rural (PMAY-R), 221.14 lakh houses were sanctioned during last five years, of which 69.71% (154.17 lakh) houses are in the name of women beneficiaries.

**(e) and (f)** Jal Jeevan Mission has been launched with an aim to provide tap water connection in every rural household by 2024. The funds are allocated to states based on rural population, SC/ST population etc. There is no component of gender-based allocation in the Scheme as the scheme aim to be provide universal coverage with the sunset date as the end of 2024. Therefore, Government does not plan to include Jal Jeevan Mission in Gender Budget Statement.

As regards Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojna, the Scheme is being implemented across the country through a Credit Guarantee Fund for Micro Units (CGFMU) which was set up in January 2016 under the aegis of the National Credit Guarantee Trustee Company Ltd. (NCGTC). The entire corpus of Rs. 3,000 crore, approved by the Cabinet for the scheme has been transferred to the fund in 2016. No requirement of additional funds has been generated under the scheme as the compliance towards repayment of loan by beneficiaries is excellent.

As on 24.02.2023, over 39.65 crore loans involving a sanctioned amount of Rs. 22.41 lakh crore have been extended since inception of the Scheme in April 2015. Out of this, 27.20 crore loans, which is 69% of total loans, amounting to sanctioned amount of Rs. 10.04 lakh crore have been extended to Women Entrepreneurs. Since no further funds are required under the scheme, it cannot be included in the Gender Budget Statement.
