(a) to (c): As reported by the States, including Madhya Pradesh, all the inhabited unelectrified villages as per Census 2011 stood electrified by 28<sup>th</sup> April, 2018 across the country under DDUGJY. A total of 18,374 villages were electrified under the scheme, including 422 villages of Madhya Pradesh. The scheme stands closed as on 31.03.2022.

As reported by the State of Madhya Pradesh, all revenue villages in Nimar region namely Barwani, Khargone, Alirajpur, Jhabua and Dhar district stand electrified.
