(a): Yes, Sir.

(b): Based on detailed analytical study of different examination systems in the country and considering the scale and scope of the mandate, NRA currently is in the final stage of scope and design for conduct of computer based Common Eligibility Test (CET).

(c): At present, besides Chairman, three officers, viz. Secretary-cum-Controller of Examination, One Director and one Deputy Secretary level Officers have been appointed in NRA (HQ).

(d): In view of (b) above, CET is yet to be conducted.
