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- (a): Government has approved Semicon India programme with a total outlay of INR 76,000 crore for development of semiconductor and display manufacturing ecosystem in the country. Total Three (3) applications have been received for setting up Semiconductor Fab facilities under the 'Scheme for setting up of Semiconductor Fabs in India'.
- (b): The applicants are actively considering various locations including Gujarat.
- (c): India Semiconductor Mission is the nodal agency toimplement the Semicon India programme. It is appraising the applications under 'Scheme for setting up of Semiconductor Fabs in India 'and 'Scheme for setting up of Display Fab in India'. The applications received for setting up of Semiconductor fabrication facilities are under appraisal.
