- (d) if so, by when the compilation will be made available for consultation and review?

**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF RAJYA SABHA
STARRED QUESTION NO. *205 “ODISHA’S PERFORMANCE IN THE SUSTAINABLE
DEVELOPMENT GOAL INDEX” RAISED BY SHRI SUJEET KUMAR:**

(a): In SDG India Index, suitable indicators are identified and mapped with the goals. Guided by National Indicator Framework developed by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, these indicators are selected in consultation with Central Ministries/Departments and States/UTs.

To determine the suitability, quantitative indicators are taken that meet the following criteria:

- i. Relevance to the SDG targets;
- ii. Guided by the National Indicator Framework (NIF);
- iii. Availability of data at national level for States and UTs from official statistical systems;
- iv. Consent from respective Ministries/ Departments;
- v. Ownership of data by the Ministries; and
- vi. Sufficient data coverage, such that data for at least 50 per cent of the States/UTs is available.

The latest data on the selected indicators is collected in collaboration with the respective ministries and the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation. The data sources for the selected indicators have been limited to (i) national survey reports of Union Ministries such as National Family Health Survey, National Sample Survey of the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, Sample Registration System of Registrar General of India, National Crime Records Bureau, All India Survey of Higher Education of the Ministry of Education etc., (ii) National data portals of Union Ministries, for example Health Management Information System of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Unified District Information System for Education-Plus (UDISE+) of the Ministry of Education etc, & MIS portals of Centrally Sponsored Schemes/Central Sector Schemes such as MIS portal of MNERGA, Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana 2.0, Jal Jeevan Mission, PMAY etc. and (iii) in some specific cases the index reports prepared by the Union Ministries such as India Innovation Index of NITI Aayog.

(b): A statement indicating Odisha's performance as per SDG India Index 3.0 (year 2020-21) is **annexed.**

(C) & (d): SDG India Index 4.0 is under preparation and it will be released after consultation with various stakeholders such as Union Ministries/ Departments, State Governments and other development agencies.
