## ANNEXURE REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PART (a) and (b) OF RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 301 ANSWERED ON 29.03.2023 ASKED BY HONB'LE MP Shri Neeraj Shekhar REGARDING 'Teacher-Pupil ratio in the country'

(a): The RTE Act, 2009 recognizes the importance of providing adequate number of teachers and lays down that the prescribed Pupil Teacher Ratio (PTR) to be maintained for each school. Para 2.3 of National Education Policy 2020 envisages Pupil-Teacher Ratio (PTR) of 25:1 in the areas having large numbers of socio-economically disadvantaged students and PTR of under 30:1in the school of other areas.
(b): The Department of School Education and Literacy (DoSEL), Ministry of Education has developed the Unified District Information System for Education Plus (UDISE+) system to record data on indicators of school education provided by all the States and Union Territories. As per data recorded in UDISE+, State/UT-wise Teacher Pupil Ratio for the year 2021-22 by the level of education at Primary, upper primary, Secondary and Higher Secondary are placed at annexure-I.

Education is in the concurrent list of the Constitution and majority of the schools are under the domain of respective State and UT Governments. Advisories to maintain appropriate PupilTeacher Ratio (PTR) have also been issued to States and UTs from time to time.
