306. SHRI VIJAY PAL SINGH TOMAR:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of National Highways (NHs) in the country, particularly in and around rural areas as on date;
- (b) the funds allocated to the State Governments for the development, improvement and maintenance of NHs during the last three years and the current year, State-wise;
- (c) action taken by Government for development and improvement of NHs in various States; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof ?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) to (d) OF RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 306 ANSWERED ON 29.03.2023 ASKED BY SHRI VIJAY PAL SINGH TOMAR REGARDING FUND FOR MAINTENANCE AND DEVELOPMENT OF NH

(a) The Ministry is primarily responsible for development and maintenance of National Highways (NHs). About 1,45,155 km length of State Roads, including State Highways (SHs), have been notified till date as NHs in the country, which also passes through rural areas.

(b) State / Union Territory (UT) - wise details of funds allocated and expenditure incurred / funds released for development and maintenance of NHs during each of the last three years and the current year are placed at Annexure-IA and Annexure-IIA respectively. Apart from this, year-wise details of funds allocated and expenditure incurred / funds released under other Schemes / Agencies for development and maintenance of NHs during each of the last three years and the current year are placed at Annexure-IB and Annexure-IIB respectively.

(c) to (d) Development and maintenance of NHs is a continuous process. Works on notified NHs, including NHs providing connectivity to rural areas, are taken up accordingly as per traffic density, condition of road, inter-se priority and availability of funds.

The development and maintenance of NHs are carried out through various agencies such as National Highways Authority of India (NHAI), National Highways & Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (NHIDCL), Border Roads Organisation (BRO), Public Works Departments (PWDs)/ Road Construction Departments (RCDs)/ Corporations of State Governments/ Union Territories (UTs).

Works in about 40,140 km length of NHs in the country, including for rural areas, were awarded during the last three years and the current year.
