(a): Participation of football team of a country in the Federation International de Football Association (FIFA) World Cup is based on the qualification as prescribed by FIFA. The All India Football Federation (AIFF), as the recognized National Sports Federation (NSF) for development and promotion of football, is responsible for taking the requisite steps so that the Indian Football Team qualifies for the FIFA World Cup, 2026. The AIFF has informed that the Indian Football Team (Men) is training and playing on regular intervals as per the FIFA International match windows.

On its part, the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports is providing all requisite support in terms of training and competitive exposure to the AIFF.

- (b): The AIFF has informed that there are more than 25 professional clubs in India where regular training happens in multiple locations across the country.
- (c): The AIFF has informed that FIFA gives equal importance to all its 211 Member Associations and has been always supportive towards India with its various projects, policies, and programs.
