INSTALLATION OF TELECOM TOWERS IN VILLAGES

1018 Shri Tiruchi Siva:

Will the Minister of Communications be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of villages in the country where telecom towers have been installed in the last three years, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the details of the number of telecom towers that Government is planning to install in the current and the next financial year; and
- (c) the other steps taken/being taken by Government to improve telecommunication network in villages and remote areas of the country?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI DEVUSINH CHAUHAN)

- (a) Sir, State/UT-wise and Telecom Service Provider (TSP)-wise number of villages in the country where Base Transceiver Stations (BTSs) have been installed in the last three years are given at **Annexure**.
- (b) & (c) BTSs/ Telecom Towers are installed by Telecom Service Providers (TSPs) to extend the coverage and capacity of their network based on techno-commercial assessment. However, the Government has set up Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF) for planning and implementing various schemes to set up mobile towers and provide telecommunication services to people in the rural and remote areas of the country. The Government through various schemes/projects under USOF is providing telecommunication services in villages and remote areas of the country. These schemes include:
 - (i) Saturation of 4G mobile services in uncovered villages across the country which envisages to provide 4G mobile services in 24,680 uncovered villages in remote and difficult areas;
 - (ii) Provision of Mobile Services in Uncovered villages in Assam, Manipur, Mizoram, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, and Arunachal Pradesh (National Highways only) of NER and seamless coverage along National Highway;
 - (iii) Provision of 4G Mobile Services in Uncovered villages of Meghalaya and seamless coverage along National Highway;
 - (iv) Provision of 4G Mobile Services in Uncovered Villages of Arunachal Pradesh;
 - (v) Provision of 4G Mobile Services in Uncovered Villages of 2 Districts of Assam; etc.
 - (vi) BharatNet project;
