DATA ON MIGRANT WORKING POPULATION IN THE COUNTRY

102. SHRI MOHAMMED NADIMUL HAQUE:

Will the Minister of Labour and Employment be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of people employed by each State in 2021-22 and 2022-23, permanent and contractual, State-wise;**
- (b) the number of people who migrated from one State to another in search of work after January 2021, State-wise; and**
- (c) the total number of migrants received by States after January 2021, State-wise?**

ANSWER

(a) to (c): The data source on Employment and Unemployment is Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) which is conducted by the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation (MoSPI) since 2017-18. The survey period is July to June of next year. The State/UT-wise estimated Worker Population Ratio (WPR) on usual status for persons of age 15 years and above during 2020-21 is at Annexure-I.

Migration of workers from one state to another state is a continuous process, and dynamic in nature. As per Census 2011 data, the total number of inter-State migrant workers in the country are 4,14,22,917. State-wise number of workers who migrated to other States in search of job is at Annexure-II.
