HOUSEHOLDS UNDER FOOD SECURITY SCHEME

Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of percentage of households covered under Food Security Scheme in the country, State-wise and district-wise;
- (b) the details of funds allocated and released for the said scheme during the last five years in the country, State-wise and year-wise;
- (c) whether it is a fact that percentage of households covered under the Food Security Act (FSA) in the State of Maharashtra is very low as compared to the target fixed;
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (e) whether Government proposes to add more beneficiaries under the said scheme; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

A N S W E R MINISTER OF STATE FOR MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD & PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a): The National Food Security Act, 2013 (NFSA) provides for coverage of upto 75% of the rural and upto 50% of the urban population of the country, which at Census, 2011 population work out to 81.35 crore persons. A statement indicating the State/Union Territory-wise percentage coverage and present coverage is at **Annexure-I**. The district-wise data is not maintained by the Central Government.

(b): Foodgrains are made available by Food Corporation of India (FCI) to the States/UTs free of cost under the NFSA, for which food subsidy is released to FCI. Only in the case of States participating in the Decentralized Procurement (DCP), under which State Government take responsibility of procurement of foodgrains and its distribution to the eligible households, that food subsidy is released directly to State Governments. Ministry of Finance allocates scheme-wise fund as a whole. There is no State-wise fund allocation for Food Subsidy. A Statement indicating the fund released to FCI and DCP States under this scheme during the last five years is at **Annexure-II**.

Central Government also provides Central assistance to States/UTs under NFSA for meeting expenditure on intra-State movement and handling of foodgrains and fair price shop dealers' margin as per provisions of the Food Security (Assistance to State Governments) Rules, 2015 as amended from time to time. A statement indicating the funds released to States/UTs under this scheme during the last five years is at **Annexure-III**.

- (c) & (d): The intended coverage under NFSA for the State of Maharashtra is 700.17 lakh persons. Presently, all the 700.17 lakh beneficiaries under NFSA have been identified by the State Government, which is 100% of the intended coverage. Hence, present coverage under NFSA is not low as compared to intended coverage.
- (e) & (f): The State Government of Maharashtra has already identified beneficiaries upto the maximum permissible limit under the NFSA. Identification of additional beneficiaries over and above the maximum permissible limit is not allowed. The Central Government issues advisories to all the States/Union Territories from time to time to identify all eligible and poor persons/ households including vulnerable Sections of the Society for inclusion under the NFSA. States are undertaking updation of their beneficiary database so that bogus ration cards get deleted and better targeting of rightful beneficiaries is ensured. Thus, deletion of ineligible beneficiaries and addition of eligible beneficiaries under the Act is a continuous process.
