FINANCIAL LOSSES IN SAFAL OUTLETS

1062 SHRI PARIMAL NATHWANI:

Will the Minister of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the SAFAL, a Government outlet for selling vegetables and fruits has incurred financial losses during the last three financial years;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether Government has conducted any study with regard to measures required to improve financial conditions of SAFAL making it economically viable and profitable; and
- (d) if so, the measures taken/plan prepared by Government to make SAFAL a profit making outlet?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) The National Dairy Development Board (NDDB) has informed that SAFAL is a registered brand under Mother Dairy Fruit & Vegetable Pvt. Ltd. (MDFVPL), a wholly owned subsidiary company of NDDB, markets fruits & vegetables. SAFAL is a brand of MDFVPL and is not a separate legal entity. The MDFVPL procures bulk of the fruits and vegetables from farmers and associates providing the growers access to the metro markets. The SAFAL outlets are operated by concessionaires, on a company-owned (viz. MDFVPL) franchise operated model, for which the concessionaires are paid commission.

The financials of MDFVPL for the last three years are given below:-
