ODOP PROGRAMME IN VARIOUS STATES

1067. SHRI VIJAY PAL SINGH TOMAR:

Will the Minister of *FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES* be pleased to state:

- (a) the quantum of funds allocated, released, and utilised under the One District One Product (ODOP) programme in various States during the last two years;
- (b) whether one of the aims of ODOP is to reduce wastage and provide support for proper storage of agricultural products and if so, the steps taken in the States in pursuance of these; and
- (c) the status of implementation of ODOP in the State of Uttar Pradesh since the launch of the scheme?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES
(SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

(a). The Prime Minister Formalisation of Micro Enterprises (PMFME) Scheme implemented by the Ministry of Food Processing Industries adopts One District One Product (ODOP) approach to reap the benefits of scale in terms of procurement of inputs, availing common services and marketing of products. The State / UT-wise details of funds (Centre share) released under PMFME Scheme is at **Annexure-I**.

(b). ODOP provides the framework for value chain development and alignment of support infrastructure. States/UTs identify the ODOP based on the agriculture production, raw material availability, perishability of the product, presence of micro enterprises, Number of Self-Help Groups (SHG) and Farmer Producer Organizations (FPO) engaged in the processing of that product. Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MoFPI) has approved ODOP for 713 districts of 35 States/ UTs.

(c). ODOP for 75 districts have been approved by MoFPI in the State of Uttar Pradesh as per the details at **Annexure-II**. The following steps have been taken by MoFPI to implement the scheme in selected ODOP districts of Uttar Pradesh:

- (i). State Nodal Department / Agency (SNA), State Level Approval Committee (SLAC) and District Level Committee (DLCs) have been constituted.
- (ii). 4 nos. of State Level Training Institutes (SLTIs) have been nominated for capacity building.
- (iii). 14 Incubation Centers have been approved.
- (iv). 250 District Resource Persons (DRPs) appointed for facilitating the prospective entrepreneurs / applicants for mobilization of proposals / applications.
- (v). 1879 applications have been submitted in ODOP out of which 340 loans have been sanctioned and 221 loans disbursed.
- (vi). 1938 SHG Members for amount of Rs. 5.01 crore have been recommended for seed capital out of which an amount of Rs. 4.79 crore has been released to 1879 SHG Members.
