(a): The Zone-wise details of vacant post of Junior Engineer under North Western Railway and Central Railway are as under:

(b) to (e): Arising and filing up of vacancies is a continuous process. Departmental selections and Limited Departmental Competitive Exams are being conducted as per selection calendar to fill up the promotional vacancies for Junior Engineers.

Approval for filling up of 6124 direct recruitment vacancies to the posts of Junior Engineers (JEs) (including 258 vacancies for North Western Railway and 491 vacancies for Central Railway) from standby list of candidates available with respective Railway Recruitment Boards (RRBs) has been issued to Zonal Railways and Production Units.
