- (c) the number of proposals from Rajasthan pending so far with the Railways at present and the details of such proposals, location and work-wise?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 1107 BY SHRI K.C.VENUGOPAL ANSWERED IN RAJYA SABHA ON 10.02.2023 REGARDING PENDING RAILWAY PROJECTS OF RAJASTHAN.

(a) to (c): Proposals/suggestions/representations, both formal and informal, including that from Hon'ble Members of Parliament are received at various levels of Railway Administration viz. Division, Zonal Headquarter and Railway Board's level for introduction of new trains, extension of existing trains, provision of stoppages, new lines, Gauge conversion, Doubling Road Over Bridges/Road Under Bridges etc., a compendium of which is not maintained. However, these are examined and action as found feasible and justified is taken from time to time.

As on 01.04.2022, 28 Projects (11 New lines, 05 Gauge conversion and 12 Doubling), costing ₹ 59,271 crore for 5,069 Km length falling fully/partly in Rajasthan are under different stages of planning/approval/execution. Out of which 1,195 Km length has been commissioned and an expenditure of ₹ 11,207 crore has been incurred upto March 2022.
