NEGLIGENCE OF ATC STAFF AT LUCKNOW AIRPORT

1121. SHRI RAM NATH THAKUR

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether it is a fact that the air traffic controller (ATC) staff at Lucknow Airport leave the operation of airplanes on the automatic devices during the night;
- (b) the number of equipments found switched off at Lucknow Airport during night;
- (c) whether switching off of these devices increases the possibility of an accident; and
- (d) steps taken to prevent such incidents at smaller airports, the details thereof?

ANSWER

Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION (GEN. (DR) V. K. SINGH (RETD))

- (a): Lucknow airport is manned and equipped to handle the present traffic requirements at the airport without compromising on safety.
- (b): No such instrument/ equipment is dysfunctional at Lucknow Airport.
- (c) & (d): No, Sir. Even in case of failure of any equipment, redundancies are available. Additionally, alternate established procedures are also available to ensure safety of the flight operations.
