## EXPANSION OF KANNUR AIRPORT, KERALA

### **ANSWER**

(a) to (c): Kannur airport in Kerala is an International Greenfield Airport developed by State Government of Kerala (GoK) through a Joint Venture Company (JVC) namely, Kannur International Airport Limited (KIAL) under Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode.

Kannur airport can accommodate up to Code "E" type aircraft and have Passenger Terminal Building with annual passenger handling capacity of 9 Million Passengers Per Annum (MPPA). Presently, KIAL has undertaken construction of a new Integrated cargo complex at the airport with an annual throughput capacity of 51,000 Million Tons.
