New coal reserves and coalfields in Assam

1143. Shri Birendra Prasad Baishya:

Will the Minister of Coal be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has identified new coal reserves and coalfields in Karbi Anglong district of Assam;
- (b) the amount of coal and natural gas exported and imported; and
- (c) the number of coal mines in operation in the country and the number of mines which are still non operative?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS, COAL AND MINES (SHRI PRALHAD JOSHI)

- (a): As per the National Inventory of Coal & Lignite Resources as on 01-04-2022, the geological resource of high sulphur coal of Mikir Hills, Karbi Anglong district of Assam stands as 3.71 million tonne.
- (b): The quantum of coal exported and imported during the Financial Year 2021-22 are 208.62686 million tonnes (provisional) and 1.31583 million tonnes (provisional) respectively. The quantum of Liquefied Natural Gas imported during the Financial year 2021-22 are 23.20 million metric tonnes and Liquefied Natural Gas has not been exported during the FY.
- (c): 487 Coal mine (including not producing) are operational and 46 coal mines are non-operational mine (all fig. are Provisional).
