CENTRAL ASSISTANCE IN AMRUT 2.0

NO. 1171. SHRI ANIL BALUNI:

Will the Minister of Housing and Urban Affairs be pleased to state:

- (a) number of schemes currently running under AMRUT 1.0 and the number of projects out of them completed so far, the amount allocated by Government for the ongoing projects under AMRUT 1.0;
- (b) number of projects being carried out under AMRUT 2.0 and the quantum of central assistance provided for these projects and by when these projects would be completed;
- (c) number of projects completed in Uttarakhand under the AMRUT 1.0 scheme and the number of projects on which work is going on; and
- (d) the number of projects on which work is going on in Uttarakhand under the AMRUT 2.0 scheme?

(a): Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) is implemented in 500 selected cities across the country focusing on development of basic urban infrastructure such as Water Supply, Sewerage & Septage Management, Storm Water Drainage, Non-motorized urban transport and Green Spaces & Parks. Under AMRUT 5,883 number of projects have been grounded so far. Of this, 4,758 number of projects have been completed. Funds under AMRUT are allocated to States/Union Territories (UTs) for State Annual Action

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Plan (SAAP)-wise and not project-wise. However, against the approved plan size of ₹77,640 crore, ₹35,990 crore has been allocated as committed central assistance for projects.

(b): The Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) 2.0 was launched on 01 October 2021 for a period of 05 years i.e. from the financial year 2021-22 to 2025-26. The mission aims at making the cities 'water secure' and provide universal coverage of water supply through functional taps to all households in all the statutory towns in the country. Mission also aims at providing sewage/ septage management to all households of 500 cities covered in first phase of the AMRUT scheme.

So far, 6,527 number of projects have been approved by this Ministry. Of these, Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) have been prepared for 1,492 projects worth ₹28,774.91 crore, tenders have been floated for 306 projects worth ₹9,796.27 crore, 166 projects worth ₹2,571.98 crore have been awarded and are under implementation. Further, six projects have been completed. So far, against the approved projects, ₹45,482 crore central assistance has been approved & ₹5,318 crore central assistance has been released.

(c): Under AMRUT 1.0, State of Uttarakhand taken up 151 projects. Of this, so far 121 projects have been completed and another 30 projects are in progress.

(d): For the State of Uttarakhand, Tranche-1 of State Water Action Plan (SWAP) have been approved by this Ministry in May 2022 for 19 projects costing ₹263.04 crore, including committed Central Assistance of ₹210.38 crore.
