(b): Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) have achieved over 10% ethanol blending in petrol during Ethanol Supply Year (ESY) 2021-22. Government has amended the National Policy on Biofuels – 2018 which has advanced the target of 20% blending of ethanol in petrol to ESY 2025-26 from 2030. E20 fuel which is a blend of 20% ethanol with petrol has been launched on 6th February, 2023 at 84 Retail Outlets of Oil Marketing Companies in 11 States/UTs.
