**LPG GAS CONNECTIONS GIVEN UNDER PMUY**

1257 Dr. Kanimozhi NVN Somu:

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of LPG gas connections given under Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY), State-wise;
- (b) the LPG gas connections given under PMUY in the State of Tamil Nadu, district-wise;
- (c) whether Government has initiated action for providing subsidy to the consumers who have taken gas connections under PMUY;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) whether Government proposes to credit the subsidy amount to the consumers under PMUY with arrears and if so, the action taken thereon?

**ANSWER**

(a) & (b) State/UT-wise details of LPG connections released under Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana(PMUY) and district-wise details LPG connections released under PMUY in the State of Tamil Nadu are at **Annexure-I and Annexure-II** respectively.

(c) to (e) Prices of LPG in the country are linked to its prices in the international market. However, for domestic LPG, Government continues to modulate the effective price to consumers. Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies(OMCs) have suffered huge losses on sale of domestic LPG. To compensate these losses, the Government has recently paid a one-time compensation of Rs. 22000 crore to OMCs.

The subsidy, as admissible, is credited to the bank account of eligible beneficiaries. In addition , the Government with effect from 21st May, 2022, has started a targeted subsidy of Rs. 200 per 14.2 Kg cylinder for Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) beneficiaries for upto 12 refills a year during 2022-23.
