GOVERNMENT PROJECTS COSTING ₹150 CRORE OR MORE

1271. SHRI DIGVIJAYA SINGH:

Will the Minister of STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to state:

(a) the number of Government projects costing ₹150 crore or more which are currently in progress in the country, when were these projects approved and the target timeframe fixed for their completion, the details thereof, department-wise; and

(b) the number of new projects costing ₹150 crore or more that were approved by Government from the year 2017 till date and the number of such projects whose cost has increased along with the extent of increase ?

**ANSWER**

(a) The Infrastructure and Project Monitoring Division (IPMD) of the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation is mandated to monitor time and cost overruns of Central Sector Infrastructure Projects costing Rs.150 crores and above based on the information provided by the project implementing agencies on Online Computerized Monitoring System (OCMS). As on 01.01.2023, 1,438 Central Sector Infrastructure projects with anticipated completion cost of Rs. 24,86,069.52 crore were on the Ministry's OCMS portal. The details and present status of currently ongoing infrastructure projects are available on the website [www.cspm.gov.in](http://www.cspm.gov.in).

(b) Total 969 new projects costing Rs 150 crore or more were approved by the Government from the year 2017 till date, and for 110 projects out of these project costs have increased by a total of Rs 25,963.36 crores as compared to their original cost.
