COST OVERRUN AND DELAY IN PROJECTS UNDERTAKEN BY DRDO

1326. SHRI ABDUL WAHAB:

Will the Minister of Defence be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of high-priority projects being undertaken by DRDO;
- (b) the number of projects which did not meet the deadlines;
- (c) the quantum of cost overrun which the extension in deadlines caused; and
- (d) whether Government has taken note of the CAG report on DRDO, if so, the steps takenby Government to reduce delays and cost overruns?

ANSWER

- (a): High priority projects are undertaken in DRDO under the Mission Mode (MM) Project Category. Currently there are 55 Nos. of ongoing MM projects such as Anti-Air Field Weapon, Solid Fuel Ducted Ramjet Technology, Surface to Air Missiles, Anti-Ship Missile, Long Range Radar, Combat Vehicles, High Endurance Autonomous Underwater Vehicle, Combat Suit for Submarines, Submarine Periscope etc.
- (b): Of these 55 Nos. of ongoing MM projects, 23 Nos. did not meet deadlines.
- (c): Of the 23 Nos. of ongoing MM projects which did not meet the deadline, 9 Nos. have undergone cost overruns. However, not all cost overruns were necessitated due to time overruns.
- (d): Following initiatives have been taken to reduce incidences of delays in DRDO projects:-
 - Mandatory focus on pre-project activity PDR mandatory before project sanction for MM projects
 - Stringent Monitoring
 - o Time estimation by an independent committee
 - Decision to close projects
 - Increased frequency of Project reviews Apex Board frequency reduced to 6 months
 - Increased involvement of Services & Production Partners during development process and reviews User participation in review meetings at all levels

- Simplified procurement policies New PM-2020 released
- Introduction of Development cum Production Partner (DcPP)/Production Agencies (PAs) more than 90
- Single User Trial FOPM by industry
- Many test facilities/ infrastructure built National Open Air Range, Hypersonic Wind Tunnel etc.
- Constitution of Joint Project Monitoring Team (JPMT) For all AoN accorded cases

Financial justification in any project proposal is vetted by Cost Estimation Committee comprising Director (Finance) or Integrated Financial Advisors (IFA) R&D as members. For project costing more than ₹75 Cr, the proposal is thereafter reviewed by Addl. FA (R&D) also during the process of project sanction.

The broad cost analysis is also presented during Peer Review or Preliminary Design Review wherein external experts and Users are members.
