BUDGET ALLOCATION FOR SMART CITIES MISSION

NO. 1338. SHRI MASTHAN RAO BEEDA:

Will the Minister of *Housing and Urban Affairs* be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of budget allocated under Smart Cities Mission (SCM) during the last five years, State-wise;
- (b) the names of the cities identified under SCM in Andhra Pradesh, phase-wise;
- (c) whether Government has looked into issues of rapid urbanisation, converting water bodies for residential requirements, and unscientific approach towards the development of cities which has led to water inundation as per experts; and
- (d) if so, the steps taken to incorporate better and more sustainable urban development techniques as part of its Smart Cities Mission?

(a) & (b) : Government of India launched Smart Cities Mission (SCM) on 25 June, 2015. 100 Smart Cities have been selected through 4 rounds of competition from January 2016 to June 2018. In the State of Andhra Pradesh, 4 cities, i.e. Kakinada & Visakhapatnam (both selected in Round-1 in January 2016), Tirupati (selected in Round-2 during May-September 2016) and Amaravati (selected in Round-3 in June 2017) were selected for development as Smart Cities. As per SCM Guidelines, Central Government will provide financial support to the extent of ₹ 48,000 crore over five years i.e., on an average ₹ 100 crore per city per year. An equal amount on a matching basis will be contributed by the State Government/Urban Local Body (ULB). The State/City-wise details of funds released under SCM is given in Annexure-I.

(c) : The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) implements urban programs and Missions which help deal with issues related to rapid urbanization across all towns and cities of the country. One such Mission, Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) launched in June 2015 is specifically focused on water related issues. Under AMRUT, States/Union Territories (UTs) have taken up 17 water body rejuvenation projects worth ₹ 114 crore. AMRUT 2.0 has been launched on October 1, 2021 for 5 years. Rejuvenation of water bodies and wells is an admissible component under AMRUT 2.0. So far 2,102 water body rejuvenation projects worth ₹ 3,664.39 crore have been approved in 1,409 ULBs under AMRUT 2.0. To help tackle water inundation, 692 Storm Water Drainage (SWD) projects worth ₹ 2,960 crore have been completed and another 117 SWD projects worth ₹ 801 crore are in progress under AMRUT.

(d) : Projects under SCM are aimed at improving liveability, economic-ability, and sustainability in cities. The focus is on sustainable and inclusive development and the idea is to look at developing compact areas, creating replicable models which will act as lighthouses to other aspiring cities through work on four pillars of comprehensive development — institutional, physical, social, and economic infrastructure. Projects under the Mission, inter alia, include development of Integrated Command & Control Centers (ICCCs), Smart Energy, Smart water & wastewater infrastructure, Smart Mobility, Vibrant Urban Spaces including smart streets, etc. Most Smart Cities have addressed issues related to sustainable development, climate change, disaster preparedness, mitigation and adaptation as part of their projects. In order to enhance walkability & increase the use of non-motorized and public transport, Smart Cities are implementing 1,619 Smart Mobility projects worth ₹ 42,731 crore. Further for driving shift towards renewable sources of energy, these cities are implementing 698 Smart Energy projects worth ₹ 14,410 crore. Efficient management of water resources is the key to climate change mitigation. Smart Cities are also implementing 1,401 Smart Water and Smart Wastewater projects worth ₹ 52,966 crore. Climate Smart Cities Assessment Framework (CSCAF) was also launched in 2019 as a mechanism to strengthen climate-sensitive development practices in cities.
