(a) & (b) :Government of India launched Smart Cities Mission (SCM) on 25 June 2015. 100 Smart Cities have been selected through 4 rounds of competition from January 2016 to June 2018. A total of 7 cities in the State of Karnataka i.e. Belagavi, Bengaluru, Davanagere, Hubballi-Dharwad, Mangaluru, Shivamogga and Tumakuru were selected for development as Smart Cities. The status of the projects of Smart Cities in Karnataka is given below:-
