REVIEW OF SMART CITIES MISSION
NO. 1347. SMT. PRIYANKA CHATURVEDI:

Will the Minister of *Housing and Urban Affairs* be pleased to state:

- (a) the percentage of total projects completed under the Smart Cities Mission;
- (b) the rate of completion/execution for fast track cities and round 4 cities;
- (c) whether any review has been conducted on the pace of execution of the project and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the proportion of Central Government contribution to the costs of completed projects as compared to other sources like PPP, convergence etc.?

(a) & (b) : As on March 3 2023, under the Smart Cities Mission (SCM), work orders have been issued in 7,799 projects worth ₹ 1,80,340 crore of which 5,399 projects worth ₹ 102,803 crore (57%) have been completed. The Smart City-wise progress of projects selected in Fast Track (May 2016) and Round-4 (January 2018) is given in Annexure-I.

(c) : The implementation of SCM at the city level is done by a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) created for the purpose. At State level, Mission implementation is coordinated by the State level High Powered Steering Committee (HPSC) chaired by the Chief Secretary of the State. At the National level, implementation of SCM is monitored by an Apex Committee headed by Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA). Nominee Directors of MoHUA on the Boards of SPVs monitor progress in respective cities on a regular basis. MoHUA regularly interacts with the States/Smart Cities through video conferences, review meetings, field visits, regional workshops etc. at various levels to assess the performance of cities and handhold them for improving the same. Smart Cities are assessed on various parameters including, but not limited to, project implementation and utilization of funds through the Real Time Online Geospatial Management Information System (GMIS).

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(d) : As per SCM Guidelines, Central Government will provide financial support to the extent of ₹ 48,000 crore over five years to the 100 Smart Cities i.e., on an average ₹ 100 crore per city per year. An equal amount on a matching basis will be contributed by the State Government/Urban Local Body (ULB). Besides the SCM funds from the Central Government and the matching share from the State/ULB, the source of fund could be loan/debt/Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode etc. The details of funding for the completed projects under SCM is given below :-
