#### NO. 1348. SHRI VAIKO: SHRI M. SHANMUGAM:

#### Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- a) the list of urban vendors provided with identity cards during last three years under National Urban Livelihoods Mission (NULM), State-wise and district-wise;
- b) details regarding the proposed projects for infrastructure development of vending zones in the country, State-wise and district-wise;
- c) status of projects sanctioned, type of projects, cost incurred, deadlines and the reasons for delay;
- d) details of areas where training programmes on financial literacy for street vendors were conducted; and
- e) number of street vendors who gained access to credit, amount of financial assistance disbursed under the component of NULM, State-wise/district wise, including Tamil Nadu?

#### **ANSWER**

# THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)

(a) to (c): State/ Union Territory (UT)-wise information of numbers of street vendors provided with identity cards under Support to Urban Street Vendor (SUSV) component of Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana – National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM) during last three years, is at Annexure-I. District-wise information of street vendors provided with identity cards is not maintained at the level of Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA).

As reported by States/UTs, a total of 13,403 vending zones have been identified as on 28.2.2023. State/UT-wise details are at Annexure-II. Details of the projects sanctioned by the State/UT is not maintained at the level of MoHUA.

(d): The guidelines of SUSV prescribe that Urban Local Body (ULB) will organize sessions on financial literacy for identified street vendors with support of resource organization and field staff. The details of such sessions are not maintained at the level of MoHUA.

MoHUA is implementing PM Street Vendor's AtmaNirbhar Nidhi (PM SVANidhi) Scheme since 1.6.2020 to facilitate collateral free working capital loan to street vendors. Digital onboarding of street vendors is an integral component of this Scheme. As such, on-boarded beneficiaries are trained in debit and credit transactions by conducting penny drop transactions within a week of loan disbursement by the concerned Lending Institutions. As on 28.2.2023, over 27.25 lakh street vendors have been digitally on boarded.

(e): State/UT-wise information including Tamil Nadu, of street vendors who received credit linkage under Self Employment Programme (SEP), a component under DAY-NULM is at Annexure-III. District-wise information is not maintained at the level of MoHUA.
