Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to State:

(a) whether Government provides financial support to the States for upgrading infrastructure of district hospitals, if so, the details thereof ;

(b) the details of the financial support provided to States for the purpose during the last five years, State/UT-wise, year-wise;
(c) the district hospitals in which infrastructures were upgraded in Tamil Nadu, during the said period;

(d) whether Government proposes to increase the amount of financial support to Tamil Nadu in the near future; and

(e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) & (b): Under the National Health Mission (NHM), financial and technical support is provided to the States/UTs for strengthening the healthcare systems including strengthening of District Hospitals, based on the proposals received from the States/UTs in their Annual Programme Implementation Plan (PIP) and subject to the Resource Envelope (RE).

A Statement showing financial support provided to the States/UTs for strengthening District Hospitals during last five financial years from 2017-18 to 2021-22 is at Annexure-I.

(c): District wise Hospital infrastructure upgraded in Tamil Nadu during last five years (2018-19 to 2022-23) is given at Annexure-II.

(d) & (e): The resource envelope of a State/UT under National Health Mission (NHM) is based on its population and a weight-age factor which depends on area of the State, health lag/socio-economic backwardness.

Based on the proposals received from the States in their Programme Implementation Plan (PIP), approvals are provided keeping in view of the resource envelope of the State as well as existing norms.
