- (a) the details of fund allocated for implementation of NEP 2020 under budgetary allocation for 2023-24, State-wise; and
- (b) the details of fund allocated, released and utilised for implementation of NEP 2020 during 2021-22 and 2022-23 till date, State-wise and year-wise?

(a) and (b): As per National Education Policy 2020, the Centre and the States / UTs work together to increase the public investment in Education sector to reach 6% of GDP. As far as Central Government is concerned, a budget provision of Rs. 112899.47 Cr. has been made for the Ministry of Education for the financial year 2023-24. Various schemes/projects/programmes run by Ministry of Education have been aligned with National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020).

The Central Government has made budgetary provision and incurred expenditure as given in table below:
