1642 **Shri Imran Pratapgarhi:**

Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

- (a) the Gross Enrolment Ratio State-wise and year-wise for last five years;
- (b) the number of girl students enrolled State-wise and year-wise for last five years;
- (c) whether there has been any assessment/study/survey conducted by Government on the qualitative and quantitative aspects of loss of learning due to lockdowns during the COVID-19 pandemic, if so, details thereof, if not, whether Government plans to conduct such a study; and
- (d) the specific policy interventions Government has implemented or plans to implement to address the unequal loss of learning for girl students due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the details thereof including targets achieved till now?

ANSWER

(SMT. ANNPURNA DEVI)

(a): The Department of School Education and Literacy (DoSEL), Ministry of Education has developed the Unified District Information System for Education Plus (UDISE+) system to record data on indicators of school education provided by all the States and Union Territories. As per UDISE+, the Gross Enrolment Ratio State-wise and year-wise for last five years are available at annexure I.

(b): As per UDISE+, the number of girls students enrolled State-wise and year-wise for last five years are available at annexure II.

(c) and (d): The Government of India has been implementing a programme of sample based National Achievement Survey (NAS) aimed at classes III, V, VIII and X with a cycle period of three years. The last round of NAS was held on November 12, 2021 across India covering students of grades 3, 5, 8 and 10. The aim and objective of NAS is to evaluate children's progress and learning competencies as an indicator of the health of the education system, so as to take appropriate steps for remedial actions at different levels. National, State/UT and District Reports for NAS 2021 have been released on 25.05.2022 and are available at <http://nas.gov.in>.

National, State/UT and District Report Cards are released and thus the learning gaps identified through these reports provide feedback to the States/UTs and Districts to take remedial measures
