EXPANSION OF NH IN MIZORAM

1694. SHRI K. VANLALVENA:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has declared any new National Highway in the State of Mizoram, if so, provide name and lanes of the road so declared; and
- (b) whether Government has any plan to construct Double-lane road from Bairabi to Mamit, Mizoram, if so, details thereof?

ANSWER

- (a) Yes, Sir. Government has declared 2 National Highways (NHs) namely NH-6 originating from Jorbat in Assam and terminating at Zokhawthar passing through Aizwal, Selling, Lumtui, Khawthlir, Tuisen, Neihdawn&Champai in Mizoram state including spur from Bairabi to Mamit and NH-502A connecting Lawngtlai to Myanmar Border including spur connecting Zorinpui- Hmawngbu near Longmasu in the state of Mizoram.
- (b) DPR for widening to 2 lane of Bairabi to Mamit section of NH-6 is in progress by State PWD and on completion of the DPR, the same would be considered for development based on the outcome of the DPR.
