- (b) States that have already initiated Virtual Experiential Museums;
- (c) The details of such museums and the fund allotted for each; and
- (d) The details of the pending applications for initiating the Virtual Experiential Museums?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF CULTURE, TOURISM & DEVELOPMENT OF NORTH EASTERN REGION (G. KISHAN REDDY)

(a),(b)&(c): Ministry of Culture operates Museum Grant Scheme under which financial assistance is provided to Centre/State Government, Autonomous bodies, NGOs, Trust, Public Sector Undertakings and Societies registered under Societies Registration Act, 1860 to develop/establish museum at regional, state and district level. Virtual Experiential Museum is one of the sub-components under Museum Grant Scheme which has been added in November, 2021. For financial year 2022-23, Rs.32.23 Crore have been allocated under Museum Grant Scheme.

Further, one Virtual Experiential Museum on Ajanta at National Museum with a project cost at Rs.8.61 Crore and another Man Mahal, Varanasi with the total project cost at Rs.7.50 Crore, has already been set up by the Ministry.

(d): One proposal of Govt. of Himachal Pradesh for development of Bantony Castle, Shimla, has been recommended by Expert Committee of Museum Grant Scheme.
