Annexure-IV to Reply for Point (d) of Rajya Sabha Admitted Unstarred Question No. 1735 on 15.03.2023

i. For Drug Addicts: To address the problem of Drug Abuse among children and women, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment has formulated and implemented National Action Plan for Drug Demand Reduction (NAPDDR) under which the Government is taking a sustained and coordinated action for arresting the problem of substance abuse among the youth and women. This includes:

- a. Launched Nasha Mukta Bharat Abhiyaan (NMBA) in 372 most vulnerable districts under which a massive community outreach is being done through more than 8000 youth volunteers. More than 9.54+ crore people have been reached out so far including 3.12+ crore youth, 2.06+ crore women and 3.14+ lakh educational institutes.
- b. 340 Integrated Rehabilitation Centres for Addicts (IRCA) are supported by the Ministry. These IRCA not only provide for treating the drug victims, but also give services of preventive education, awareness generation, motivational counselling, detoxification/de-addiction, after care and re-integration into the social mainstream. Ministry also provided support to special de-addiction centre for women and children.
- c. 48 Community based Peer led Intervention (CPLI) Centres are supported by the Ministry. These CPLIs focus on vulnerable and at risk children and adolescents. Under this, peer educators engage children for awareness generation and life skill activities.
- d. 71 Outreach and Drop In Centres (ODICs) are supported by the Ministry. These ODICs provide safe and secure space of treatment and rehabilitation for substance users, with provision of screening, assessment and counselling and thereafter provide referral and linkage to treatment and rehabilitation services for substance dependence.
- e. Ministry also supports setting up of 46 Addiction Treatment Facilities (ATFs) in some Government hospitals, which is being implemented through AIIMS, New Delhi.
- f. A Toll-free Helpline for de-addiction, 14446 is being maintained by the Ministry for providing primary counseling and immediate assistance to the persons seeking help through this helpline.
- g. Ministry through its autonomous body National Institute of Social Defence (NISD) and other collaborating agencies like SCERTs, Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan etc. provides for regular awareness generation and sensitization sessions for all stakeholders including students, teachers, parents.

ii. For Senior Citizens: The Ministry has taken various awareness measures for promotion of the Scheme. During 2021-22, applications were invited for new projects in 104 gap districts under Integrated Programme for Senior Citizen (IPSRc). During 2022-23, applications were invited for new projects in 103 gap districts.

iii. For Transgenders: Awareness programmes are regularly organized by the Department through National Institute of Social Defense. In 2022-23, regional workshops for awareness generation on the Transgender Persons (Protection of Rights) Act 2019 and matters related to transgender persons, have been organized in collaboration with NITI Aayog and United Nations Development Programme at Mumbai, Bhubaneswar, Guwahati, Lucknow & Chennai.
