- (a) the present status of programme production and broadcasting in All India Radio station at Kokrajhar, Assam;
- (b) the follow up action on the decision taken for the upgradation of the station along with the present status of infrastructure development in terms of financial and physical targets; and
- (c) the details of present status of programme staff employed therein?

(a) to (c): AIR, Kokrajhar is a Primary Channel, having two transmissions in morning (from 0553 hours to 0945 hours) and evening (from 1623 hours to 2230 hours). The duration of production (originated) programmes is 6 hours and 28 minutes.

Prasar Bharati has informed that action has been initiated to procure a 10 kW Frequency Modulation transmitter for AIR, Kokrajhar. Apart from this, refurbishing of studios at AIR, Kokrajhar has also been started.

The Programme Services in AIR Kokrajhar are managed by a mix of regular employees and casual assignees.
