- (a) the details of locations where the stations of Akashvani and Doordarshan have been set up in the country, State-wise;
- (b) whether Government has prescribed any criteria for setting up of such studios, if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether Government proposes to set up new studios of Doordarshan and Akashvani in different States, especially in Maharashtra; and
- (d) if so, the time by which it is likely to be set up and if not, the reasons therefor?
