DETAILS OF ITEMS INCLUDED IN CPI-IW BASE

Will the Minister of Labour and Employment be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of 465 items which are included in CPI-IW base year 2016 along with their respective weightage percentage at present;
- (b)whether weightage of above items have been changed during 2021, 2022 and 2023 till date;
- (c)if so, the details of such changes; and
- (d)if not, the reasons for lower CPI-IW when inflation has been highest in three decades?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

(a) to (d): The 465 items which are included in Consumer Price Index Numbers for Industrial Workers (CPI-IW) with base year 2016=100 are classified in various groups. The groups along with their respective weightage percentage at present are given below:

| Groups | CPI-IW (2016=100) (Weight %) |

| Food & Beverages | 39.20 |
| Pan, Supari, Tobacco & Intoxicants | 1.80 |
| Clothing & Footwear | 5.95 |
| Housing | 17.75 |
| Fuel & Light | 5.49 |
| Miscellaneous | 29.81 |
| Total | 100.00 |

The weights once finalized during base year, remains unchanged throughout the life of series except for fruits and vegetable items which are affected by seasonality factor.

The rate of inflation measured by CPI-IW has been moderate in recent months as compared to the data for last three decades.
